

MASK INFORMATION—They are the ones we had available for you last weekend.—We ask that you **NOT USE THE MASK, and dispose of it at this time.**

FACE MASK ADVISORY The Tennessee Department of Health says County Health Departments have stopped handing out free face masks due to some potential concerns about their safety. That includes the McMinn County Health Department which had been giving masks to individuals, families, and churches. The black masks, which are made by a sock company in Cleveland, were treated with Silvadur, an anti-microbial substance applied to cloth to reduce odor-causing bacterial growth. The EPA in 2017 issued a document saying Silvadur can “cause irreversible eye damage, cause skin burns, and is harmful if swallowed or inhaled.” The Health Department is asking the public to refrain from using and distributing the masks until more data is available about the application of Silvadur to these masks. Silvadur says they’ve used what they call a “safe and trusted” technology to control bacteria that causes odors on fabric for more than a decade with no adverse health effects
