

My dear parishioners,

Peace! Among the sixteen documents of the Second Vatican council (1962-1965) is the Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World, *Gaudium et spes*. In an earlier project published as *Dogmatic Questions and Answers for the Year of Faith* (Charlestown, SC: Createspace, 2012) the three constitutions on the Church, on Divine Revelation and on the Sacred Liturgy (*Lumen Gentium, Dei Verbum,* and *Sacrosanctum Concilium* respectively) were considered. The following questions and answers have been drawn up in anticipation of the 60th anniversary of *Gaudium et spes* in 2025.

**491. What often results when we indulge in too many of life's comforts (GS, 31.2)?** Human freedom is crippled and we find ourselves imprisoned in a kind of splendid isolation

#### 492. How does freedom acquire new strength (GS, 31.2)?

When we consent to the unavoidable requirements of social life

493. How is it that we consent to the unavoidable requirements of social life (GS, 31.2)?

By taking on the manifold demands of human partnership and committing ourselves to the service of the human community

**494.** What do the Council Fathers encourage everyone everywhere to do (GS, 31;3)? To play the proper role in common endeavors

495. Regarding participation in public affairs with great freedom, what is held out for praise (GS, 31.3)?

National procedures which allow the largest possible numbers to participate

496. Regarding the participation of large numbers of citizens in public affairs, what is to be taken account (GS, 31.3)?

The actual conditions of each people and decisiveness required by public authority
