Sacrament:

Baptism – To baptize your child you must –

Contact the office at 423-745-4277, or stop by to complete a Baptism Form. You will need to bring with you the child's state issued Birth Certificate. You as parents are required to take classes for Baptism. We will notify the instructors either Paulette Croteau or Alica Mora, who will schedule classes with the parents. God-Parents –You only need one God Parent. They/He/She must be a practicing Catholic, if married, married in the Catholic Church. If they are **not** from our parish we will need a letter from their home parish, letting us know that they are active member of their parish, in good standing and have completed classes for Godparents. Once all of the requirement are met we will schedule a date for Baptism.

First Communion-and Reconciliation -

Normally 2nd Grade and older students may be included - Must have attended CCD the prior year and the year of the Sacrament.- If you were **not** Baptized at St. Mary will need a new original from your home parish of Baptism.

Confirmation- is Two Year Program -

For 5th and 6th grades and may include other students that may have missed this sacrament. Must have attended CCD the prior year and the year of the Sacrament. If you were **not** baptized at or received First Communion here at St. Mary we will need a recent original of your Baptism and First Communion record from your home parish.

Marriage – Must make an appointment will Fr. John Arthur Orr. He will need recent originals of your Sacraments you have received if they were not received at St. Mary Parish.

RCIA – For Non-Catholics who would like to become Catholic or Returning Catholics who have not received all of their Sacraments.

For non-Catholic we will need a copy or letter from the Church you were baptized with that information.

For a Catholic returning to the Church, we will need a recent original of the Sacraments you have received, if not received at St. Mary Parish.

We have a basket on the narthex table for you to place your Palms in from last year.
